There are approximately 550 seats available in the Kamiakin auditorium where shows will take place, though social distancing will be in effect. Previous productions have brought in over 500 patrons throughout the entire run, and we expect this production to have a similar draw. Performances of *Trap* will take place at 7 p.m. November 18th, 19th, & 20th in the KaHS auditorium.

*Trap* is told mockumentary style, reporting on an incomprehensible event: every person in the audience of a high school play falls unconscious--every person but one. Using interviews with witnesses, loved ones, first responders, and the investigators pursuing the case, our theatre ensemble brings the story of the strange event to life, documentary-style. But as the strands weave together into an increasingly dangerous web, it becomes clear that this phenomenon might not be entirely in the past. Unnerving, exhilarating, and wildly inventive, our audiences have never walked into anything quite like *Trap*.
