STATE THESPIAN OFFICER APPLICATION PACKET

Dear Prospective State Thespian Officers, Parents, and Troupe Directors,

Please read the following packet thoroughly. It contains important information that will guide you in making the decision to possibly run for a State Thespian Officer position. If you decide that being an STO is for you, this packet also contains the application pages necessary to declare yourself a candidate. Being elected to the State Thespian Board is a tremendous honor and a great responsibility. STO's must be at all required meetings and are responsible for transportation to and from these meetings, which will be spread throughout the state of Indiana.

Once you have read through the materials, please complete the necessary questionnaires and short answers. Take note of the pages that must be completed by your Troupe Director and parent/guardian. All pages that you complete should be mailed under the same cover to the Indiana STO Advisor: Grant Steckbeck at 557 Renz Ave. Sellersburg, IN 47172. All Materials must be postmarked by Monday, December 15th. Note that if any required paperwork is missing, a student will not be considered a running candidate.

Once you have applied, your paperwork will be reviewed by the STO Advisor, Assistant Advisor, and the current Senior State Thespian Officers. While at State Conference, on Friday night, you will meet for an interview session with the other STO candidates, the STO Advisor, and Assistant Advisor, and the current Senior Student Thespian Officers. During this session, questions will be asked of all the candidates. Many of the STO's will also be mingling with candidates all weekend. On Saturday during lunch, there will be an STO meeting. Everyone will simply meet up to eat lunch together and mingle. On Friday and Saturday, the Advisors and Student Board will be looking for STO candidates that display---enthusiasm, a willingness to work with others, strong communication skills, respect, kindness and friendliness toward others, initiative, a passion for the Indiana Thespian organization, and exhibit a dedicated nature.

Student Thespian Officer Duties:

- 1. STO members must attend all STO planning meetings, the Indiana Leadership Conference, Regional Conferences, and the State Conference. Attendance is mandatory. No more than one absence, excused in advance by the STO Advisor or State Director is permitted. Failure to attend will be treated as a resignation. When possible, attendance to the International Thespian Festival is recommended.
- 2. STO members must secure their own transportation to and from all of the STO events listed in Duty #1. STO members must understand that these events occur all over the state of Indiana.
- 3. STO members must actively solicit individual troupe involvement in Regional, State, and International Thespian activities. STO members must address individual troupe concerns through appropriate legislation in conjunction with the State Director and STO Advisor.
- 4. STO members must advise the State Director and STO Advisor about student concerns and seek input in our State organization.
- 5. STO members must prepare and present an informative, helpful and well thought out leadership workshop for the Leadership Conference.
- 6. STO members must generate and conduct student activities for State Conference.
- 7. STO members must work with the Adult Executive Board to award the All Star Awards for plays at the Regional Conferences.
- 8. STO members must fulfill all State Conference responsibilities.
- 9. STO members must serve their term beginning at the Spring AEB/STO required meeting and end one year later at the conclusion of the International Thespian Festival.
- 10.STO members serve one term after being elected; however, STO members who begin on the board as juniors are allowed to apply to serve a second term their senior year. They will have to undergo the application/interview process, the same as new applicants, in order to secure a second term.

Student Thespian Officer Board:

- 1. Whenever possible, the STO board will consist of eight to ten Thespians, elected by the current (senior) members of the STO board, the STO Advisor and Assistant Advisor, the State Director, and other AEB members.
- 2. Each school may send up to 3 STO candidates.
- 3. STO candidates and electors will meet together many times during the State Conference. Therefore, it is mandatory for applicants to attend the State Conference.
- 4. The election results will be announced on Sunday during the State Conference.

Basic Student Executive Board Yearly Calendar:

Spring/Summer AEB/STO Meeting (Saturday in April/May usually)
Summer AEB/STO Meeting (Saturday in August usually)
Leadership Conference (Saturday in September)
Regional Conferences (usually 3-4 Saturdays in October/November or December, with the exception of Thanksgiving weekend)
State Conference (Friday-Sunday in January)
Summer AEB/STO Meeting (Saturday in May/June usually)

(Other select meetings will be added according to need. If additional meetings are needed in order to plan for the State Conference, they will be added. Members are also strongly encouraged to attend the International Thespian Festival in Lincoln, Nebraska for a week in June.)

Note: The Spring Board meeting is the first required meeting for the new STO members, and the last meeting for the previous year's STO members. Both will be in attendance since training of the new STO members will need to take place.

Application Materials:

Before you proceed, make sure that you talk with you parents and Troupe Director. Make sure that you have their support because you'll need it!

- 1. Take some time to think about the questions put forth in this packet. Some of them require signatures and/or initialing by your parents/guardian and Troupe Director. Don't overlook this aspect. Incomplete forms will not be accepted.
- 2. Complete all the candidate forms and mail, with a theatrical resume, to:

All forms must be postmarked by Monday, December 15th.

- 3. Give your Troupe Director the appropriate forms and evaluations with a stamped, addressed envelope. Your Troupe Director will need to complete the forms and use the envelope to mail them to the STO Advisor at the address above. These forms are confidential and you should not view them. Be sure to allow your Troupe Director enough time to thoughtfully complete the forms.
- 4. During State Conference weekend, you will be required to attend Friday night's STO candidate interview session and Saturday's STO candidate luncheon.
