The traditional American musical uses spoken dialogue, song lyrics, and dance to develop plot and characters.

- 1. Describe one song and what its lyrics told you about a particular character. *Be specific!*
- 2. Describe one time when song lyrics further developed the plot. Tell the plot piece the song lyrics gave you. *Be specific!*
- 3. Describe a point at which dance helped to define the personality or state of mind of a character or group of characters. *Be specific!*
- 4. Describe a point when dance further developed the plot. *Be specific!*

Movies of musicals usually "open up" a stage play, although they might not add or change dialogue, songs, or dance. They add different locations, frequently many more than would be practical on stage.

- 7. Tell one location that appeared in the movie that you think would <u>not</u> be essential on the stage. Explain.
- 8. Who was your favorite character? Why?
- 9. What was your favorite point in the movie? Why?
- 10. What was your least favorite point or characteristic of the movie? Why?
