## NMSU Theatre Arts Department Head, Wil Kilroy, and Lisa Dalton

Wil Kilroy is the NMSU Theatre Arts Department Chair and Professor of Theatre at NMSU, Director of the Michael Chekhov Theatre Institute for actors and teachers, since 1994, and the USM Theatre Academy for 13 - 18 year olds, and Vice President of the National Michael Chekhov Association.



Wil and his partner Lisa Dalton began teaching Michael Chekhov acting classes with Mala Powers in 1993 and they formed the National Michael Chekhov Association in 1994. For 13

years, they taught the annual Chekhov Theatre Intensive program each year at University of Southern Maine and made that training program part of the USM curriculum. When Mala Powers died in 2007, they carried on the training program. When Lisa Dalton moved to Texas in 2009, the training program was brought to Texas, where it's been presented every year. Lisa and Wil have now taught the very popular Theatre Intensive for 23 consecutive years and have expanded it to twice per year, Winter or Spring and Summer.
