1. **What is the Disney Performing Arts Conservatory?**

The Disney Performing Arts Conservatory is a summer program that offers an “Instrumental Conservatory” and a “Musical Theatre Conservatory” that gives young performers ages 14 through 22 the opportunity to improve their performance skills through immersive classes, professional panels and behind-the-scenes experiences. Each Conservatory consists of 5 consecutive days/8 hours per day of a comprehensive series of workshops taught by entertainment professionals, culminating with a final performance in one (1) of the Theme Parks at the *Disneyland*® Resort!

2. **What instrumentation is planned for the Instrumental Conservatory?**

There will be spots for a Symphonic Orchestra consisting of Brass, Woodwind, Strings and Percussion players.

3. **What music level do instrumental participants need to sight read/play?**

All instrumental participants must be able to sight read and play grade 3 music.

4. **What performance background is required for Musical Theatre Conservatory?**

Although there is not a set number of years of experience required, musical theatre participants should have a basic understanding of and be comfortable with singing, dancing and acting on a stage.

5. **Is there an evaluation for the Conservatories?**

During the registration process, we will require that all registrants submit a sample of their talent. This is not an audition, but a tool to show us your talents. This evaluation will help us prepare and make the final live performance on stage successful and exciting. The submission must include three (3) components: (1) photo/headshot, (2) resume or a list of your performing arts experience and education, and (3) a one-two (1-2) minute video showcasing your talent. Instructions on how to submit your performance evaluation will be available at the time of registration.

7. **What type of *Disneyland*® Resort Theme Park Ticket will be included with the cost of the Disney Performing Arts Conservatory?**

Each Conservatory participant will receive one (1) 1-Day *Disneyland*® Resort Park Hopper® Ticket valid on the final day of the Conservatory for use by the participant only. Ticket is non-upgradeable and expires on the last day of the Conservatory.

8. **Will additional *Disneyland*® Resort Theme Park Tickets be available for purchase for Conservatory participant and their guests?**

A link to purchase additional *Disneyland*® Resort Theme Park Tickets will be provided with the Disney Performing Arts Conservatory confirmation email. Separate theme park admission is required for guests of participants and for visits to the Theme Parks by participants that are not part of the Conservatory schedule.

9. **Are Chaperones required during the Conservatory?**

Chaperones are not required.

10. **Can I apply my Annual Passport toward the cost of the Conservatory?**

No discounts or offers may be applied to the cost of the Conservatory.

11. **Does *Disneyland*® Resort provide transportation or lodging?**

No transportation or lodging will be provided in the cost of the Conservatory.

12. **What is the Disney Performing Arts Conservatory refund policy?**

The Disney Performing Arts Conservatory is non-refundable and nontransferable. Other restrictions may apply.
